


FACEBOOK

1. To open a facebook page go to www.facebook.com
2. The following menu will open

You will have to enter all the information requested (including your birth date, this is necessary for authenticity and is required to open a facebook account), enter your email and create a password. This will be the same location where you will enter your username (email address) and password to get to your facebook, so be sure to save the URL to your favorites.

3. Once your account is activated you will have the options of:
 - Entering your information, the less the better!
 - Putting a photo on your page and seeking friends via your email account.

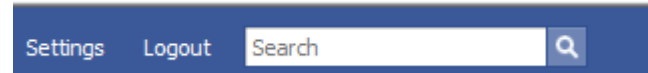
Be careful not to use your email address book when they request it otherwise "EVERYONE" in your list will get an invitation to join your facebook, if you don't want everyone to get an invitation.

 - You can seek out friends by using the search option.
 - You are able to upload photos and comments that you want to share with you facebook friends.
4. You will have the option of inviting individual friends to join you and you may get an invitation from others to join their facebook

but you always have the option of refusing anyone, as they have the same option to refuse you.

5. To deactivate your account:

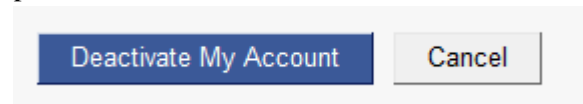
From your home page, select "**SETTINGS**"



then scroll down to

Deactivate Account

You will be asked why you are deactivating, you have the option of not replying, scroll down to the bottom for the final deactivation part



once you click on this your account will be deactivated but "NOT" closed, in case you want to reactivate at a later date.
